## BUYER INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

The Directors, Officers, and Chairpersons would like to extend our appreciation for your participation in the Brazos County Youth Livestock Show's Premium and Freezer Auctions. This is the culmination of the exhibitor's work in his or her project area.

### **BUYER REGISTRATION**

**New Buyers:** Register online at <https://bcyla.fairwire.com/buyer> and check "I am a new buyer or not listed above"

**Previous Buyers:** Check and update your information at <https://bcyla.fairwire.com/buyer> by selecting your name in the drop-down menu. All passwords have been set to 1234. This can be reset once you have logged in. Please verify that all of your contact information is correct.

### **AUCTION BUYERS**

- If you would like to bid in the premium or freezer auctions, please register online and then visit the buyer registration table on sale day to obtain your bidder number.
- Projects may be purchased by individuals, companies, or a group of individuals/companies, e.g. a buyer's group.
- Within minutes of purchasing the project, you will be asked by a ring attendant to sign for your purchase
- For market steers, barrows, goats, and lambs you will have the option to select whether you would like the animal processed or sent to resale. Please fill out the bottom of the sale ticket accordingly.
- Buyers will be responsible for processing fees and for picking up the meat once it is ready. Processor options are K&C Meat Processing in Navasota, and Dime Box Meat Market.
- If you select resale, the resale amount (listed on the sale order) will be credited towards your purchase.
- For market poultry and rabbits, you will have the option to have the meat processed and delivered to you by the exhibitor.
- The Association will bill you for your purchase(s) within 30 days of the sale.
- No add-ons from the floor of the sale will be accepted. Use the add-on sheets obtained from the add-on table. The Association wants to emphasize the Premium Buyers and any add-ons from the floor are a distraction from the Premium Buyer's publicity.

### **ADD-ON BUYERS**

- You can help exhibitors by pledging a monetary amount of your discretion. This pledge can be made to any exhibitor regardless of whether or not their project made the premium or freezer sale. A complete list of all exhibitors will be available at <https://bcyla.fairwire.com/addons>.
- Add-Ons can be made on our website at <https://bcyla.fairwire.com/addons> beginning at 6 pm on March 28, 2025 through April 13, 2025.
- On sale day you can also visit the Add-On Table to make your contribution.
- Payments can be made online by credit card (with 3.5% processing fee added), by cash or check at the Add-On Table on sale day, or we can send you an invoice.
- No add-ons from the floor of the Premium or Freezer Sales will be accepted. Use the add-on process detailed above.
